HOLIDAY CLOSURES: Almont Township Offices will be closed as follows:

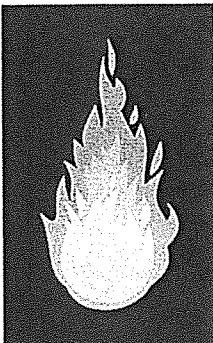
NO POSTMARKS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

ONLINE BANKING AVAILABLE : Pay your current tax bill in the convenience of your home directly out of your bank account. Simply set up your account with your bank to do online bill paying. Your payment will come directly to the Township Tax account and we will mail you a receipt.

(We will not have any of your account information)

CREDIT/DEBIT CARD PAYMENT: You may pay your current tax bill with your credit or debit card through "Point & Pay". Simply go to our Township website.
