A special meeting of the Almont Township Planning Commission was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Chair Steve Francis at the Almont Township /Village Hall, 817/819 N. Main Street, Almont, Michigan 48003. Roll call was taken.

NEW BUSINESS: #1. #14-005 – 3578 Van Dyke (Interpower/Springfield Industries) Bldg. addition

Mr. Craig Lamiman, Chief Operating Officer, of Interpower Induction was present along with their architect, Mr. Orin Campbell. Mr. Lamiman noted that they would like to construct a 3,936 square foot addition that would be used for cold storage by their tenant Springfield industries, Inc.

Mr. Campbell noted that all concerns from Mr. Piggott of Rowe Professional Services and Mr. Mabery, PE of Davis Land Surveying & Engineering have been addressed on the latest site plan received by the Township and given to the Planning Commissioners on December 17, 2014. Mr. Campbell noted that the existing catch basin will be relocated pursuant to the engineer's review and will be inspected and approved by the engineer.

#1. #14-005 – 3578 Van Dyke (Interpower/Springfield Industries) Bldg. addition continued:

Board discussion followed. Concern was expressed on protecting the shared easement. Mr. Lamiman noted that in their packets there were copies of an approval letter from Tilmar Spline, Inc. and that the Township had the original copy of the approval letter from James T. Ligon, which was signed by Mr. Ligon before the meeting. Discussion was briefly held on making sure that an "as built" copy of the site plan was included in the file.

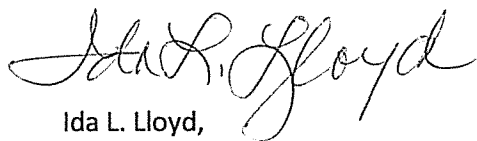
